COURSE RESUME

ARMY WING (DSCSC COURSE 2022)

The Beginning

'Knowledge is Power'- was the motto that motivated 134 inquisitive minds of the Army Wing to join DSCSC by 14 February 2022 along with their families. DSCSC solemnly greeted the newly-arrived officers who were accommodated in DSCSC residential area, Krishnochura, and Sheuly apartments. Apart from that, 27 overseas army officers from 21 friendly foreign countries joined the course by 05 February 2022. It is mentionable that three officers from Bangladesh Police also joined the DSCSC course in 2022, and out of them, two were with Army Wing. After completing the necessary formalities and preparations, the course participants were set to start and explore the long, arduous; yet very rewarding journey ahead.

First Term

20 February 2022 marked the beginning of the long and challenging voyage. The first event of the course was the colourful Flag Raising Ceremony, where course participants from every nation raised their national flags. The Ice Breaking Ceremony was instrumental to create a harmonious and conducive environment through spontaneous and lively interactions with the faculty members and peers. The Mirpur Hall, the Heritage Building, and the Sheikh Hasina Complex were the venues for academic activities where presentations, syndicate discussions, and exercises became indispensable parts of their life. Exercise GYAN JACHAI-1 was the first test to assess the course participants' background knowledge. It was followed by Exercise KOTHAMALA-1, which allowed the course participants to orally express their thoughts and ideas. Exercise MUKTOCHINTA-1 was arranged to assess the analytical ability and English writing skills of the course participants. Apart from these exercises, the course participants prepared themselves exhaustively to make the syndicate discussions more effective. Besides, the Individual Research Paper (IRP) started under the supervision of respective Directing Staff (DS) and continued until the fourth term. An open-book exam on basic staff knowledge was conducted, which proved quite challenging for the course participants. Exercise BORENDRA PRACHIR bolstered the essential learning on operation order, and it solidified the confidence of the course participants in crafting such papers. Second Term

After the first term break and Eid-ul-Fitr leave, the second term started on 08 May 2022. At the very outset, the course participants attended Exercise MUKTOCHINTA-2 projecting their analytical writing skills. It was followed by Exercise OVIBAKTI-1 where course participants were tested on their argumentative writing skills. Next, Exercise PRAN SHONCHAR was conducted to test the ability to formulate an administrative order effectively. Thought-provoking syndicate discussions were conducted on offensive operations followed by the Yellow Land package. A map exercise on assault river crossing was conducted to enhance the knowledge on bridgehead operation. The first tactical exercise of the course, EXERCISE SHOKTO PRACHIR was conducted in Saidpur, where the course participants were tested in the field on defensive operations. After that, they participated in a map exercise on offensive operations named Exercise MORON CHOBOL. In the meantime, the course participants appeared in Exercise GYAN JACHAI-2, which tested their aptitude on subjective knowledge. During this term, several renowned scholars visited DSCSC and shared their vast experience and knowledge with the course participants. Counter Insurgency Operation (CIO), International Relations, Disaster Management, International Humanitarian Law, Unconventional Warfare, Information Warfare, etcetera were the core modules of this term. The CIO seminar presented through VTC by the Staff College delegation of Sri Lanka was an eye-opening event. Besides, the course participants were also busy with their research work. Nevertheless, Exercise THUNDER STRIKE surprised them at regular intervals. Exercise NOGOR DURGO was conducted on defence while fighting in a built-up area.

The same exercise allowed the course participants to validate their plan in a Computer Assisted Exercise based on their plan, which was a unique experience for them. Finally, the term ended with the colourful and enchanting cultural program arranged by the Army Wing.

Third Term

The third term was very intense and the longest. The term started with Exercise NETRITTER DORSHON which gave the course participants exposure to formulating the command philosophy as a unit's commanding officer. Then Exercise OVIBAKTI-2, followed by Exercise MUKTOCHINTA-3 was conducted to test their English writing skills. Deposition of 60% work of IRP provided great relief to all the course participants. The course participants were engulfed in the quicksand of Exercise CHORA BALI spanning over two weeks. However, they could find their way out of it by validating their plan through a CPX which was full of learning. Subjects like joint operations, military strategy, and operational art and design were introduced in this term. Exercise GHURNIJHAR allowed them to experience the ground realities through TEWTS held in the Rajendrapur area. It was followed by Exercise PURBO DIGONTO which depicted a real scenario of the defensive operation. Exercise SAMORIK BIBORTON was also knowledge-enriching as it was designed to study the recent and ongoing military conflicts around the globe. Later, the first joint exercise of the course, Exercise HATIKHEDA, familiarized the course participants with planning an amphibious operation. After quite a long journey through the intense course curriculum and a lot of speculation and fantasy, the course participants were indeed fortunate to have the Overseas Study Tour (OST). Fourth Term

The International day and the Food Festival were colourful and gorgeous. Exercise SOMOR NAKSHA gave the course participants the unique opportunity to work in a joint environment at strategic and operational levels to learn strategic analysis and elements of operational art and design. It was followed by Exercise BHABISHAYAT, which gave broad exposure to the course participants of all three wings on the mechanism involved in formulating the Forces Goal and Perspective Plan within the available budget. The course participants appeared at the Viva-Voce for IRP Defence. The most important event of DSCSC Course 2022 was Exercise AGNI BEENA, which began on 09 November 2022 and ended on 28 November 2022. This exercise was indeed an arduous but the most effective exercise in the staff course. The exercise could successfully integrate jointness and gave the course participants a comprehensive idea of formulating a military campaign and support campaign plan at the operational level. Finally, the CPX completed the learning by executing the plan at the tactical level. Casting Off

The trumpet of the official inauguration of DSCSC-2022 was played on 24th February 2022 through a colourful Flag Raising Ceremony. The day was memorable for all 45 Bangladesh Navy course participants and seven overseas course participants from India, Pakistan, Malaysia, Saudi Arabia, Nigeria, Sri Lanka, and Tanzania. Such a blend of officers from numerous cultures and traditions has added more colour to the course. Moreover, three officers from Bangladesh Police joined the course who were attached to the Navy wing at different times. The opening address by the Commandant and Chief Instructor generated enthusiasm among the course participants. The faculty members were introduced by CI and SI(Navy) respectively. Moreover, SI (Navy)'s inspiring words have set the sail to a new horizon for the course participants. During the ice-breaking ceremony arranged in the afternoon, course participants of all wings came close together to reach a common destiny. All the Navy Wing course participants set their sail for a new beginning.

First Term

The glorious journey began on 24th February 2022. The first term was mainly focused on individual service matters. However, the course participants got exposure to the joint classes in a limited scope. Ex GYAN JACHAI-1 was conducted to evaluate the primary knowledge of the course participants at the beginning of the course. Distinguished professors took classes on effective English writing and Research Methodology. A series of central presentations on different services and corps along with their role and duties were delivered by services' representatives. Emphasis was given to furnishing the course participants with a clear understanding of Research Methodology in order to produce an Individual Research Paper (IRP) at the end of the course. EX MUKTOCHINA (an analytical writing test) and EX KOTHAMALA (extempore speech) were conducted to develop the communication skill of the course participants. Course participants were exposed to extensive use of JSSDM, Law of the Sea, San Ramos Manual, Laws of Armed Conflicts, and basic naval warfare tactics. Besides, classes were conducted on scouting, underwater and above-water warfare to impart naval tactics. Thereafter, the Navy Wing course participants were exposed to the Intelligence Preparation of the Operational Environment (IPOE) and Navy Planning Process (NPP) package. They have learned the art and science of naval operational planning to master the naval operational concept. They were taught the importance of Air Power in the context of modern warfare. Moreover, to have adequate knowledge of regional and global neighbours' military capability, EX PROTIBESHI was conducted. In addition, EX SHOMUDRA SHONGHAT has also enabled course participants with a detailed analysis of contemporary naval wars. Course participants were asked to analyse the maritime doctrine of our neighbouring countries, including the developed maritime nations, to suggest and recommend options to improve the Maritime Doctrine of Bangladesh. Finally, Term-1 was terminated with a realistic logistic exercise named EX SHOMUDRA JATRA.

Second Term

The term commenced with argumentative writing in the form of EX OVIBAKTI-1 followed by EX MUKTOCHINTA-2, which provided an opportunity to develop the writing skill of the course participants. EX GYAN JACHAI-2 was conducted to evaluate the learning of the course participants during Term-1. They were exposed to joint syndicate discussions on security affairs. Unconventional warfare and Counter Insurgency Operations (CIO) were introduced during this term. Officers were tasked to research specific topics of CIO operation by the Bangladesh Armed Forces in the CHT area. Besides, exhaustive discussion on YELLOW LAND by the subject matter experts has developed an understanding of the perceived conventional threats

from the eastern neighbour of Bangladesh. Course participants conducted group research on numerous maritime disputes around the globe and analysed the verdict of the courts to impart lessons on maritime laws. Numerous symposiums and seminars on contemporary issues have enriched the course participants with added knowledge. EX LOKKHOMATRA educated them on numerous issues related to the procurement process of naval platforms. Finally, tactical level exercise followed by tabletop wargame EX BIVISHON has offered the course participants tactical mastery of naval warfare. In addition, in this term, course participants visited Khulna Naval Area, Mongla Port Authority, Khulna Shipyard, and Commander Flotilla West to have a clear understanding of the roles and functions of the respective organisations. They have also visited the UNESCO World Heritage Site 'Shat Gombuz Mosque' in Bagherhat.

Third Term

The third term is known as the most intense term with numerous joint exercises. It is also recognised as the 'Term of Strategy', as land, maritime, and air strategy were exposed to the course participants. The term started with EX OVIBAKTI-2. To inculcate command philosophy among the course participants, EX NETRITTER DORHON was conducted. EX MUKTOCHINTA-3 allowed the course participants to write another analytical paper on a given topic. The main focus of the term was operational art and design, campaign planning, strategic analysis, amphibious warfare, etc. EX PROTIRODH was a major single-service exercise to practice the relevant concept of operational art and design. Moreover, EX GUNGCHIL was conducted in a joint Navy-Air environment. A maritime strategy seminar was conducted where subject matter experts evaluated the strategic concept of course participants. Course participants were exposed to Action Speed Tactical Trainer (ASTT) in SMWT, Chottogram through intense wargames both in single and multi-threat environments. Course participants of Air Wing have also joined in the wargame. Furthermore, Navy and Air wing course participants visited Special Warfare Diving and Salvage (SWADS) Command and learned the role and functions of the BN Special Force. A daylong visit to the Chottogram Port Authority by the Navy Wing participants has furnished them with added maritime knowledge. Through EX HATIKHEDA, the course participants got an insight into an amphibious operation jointly conducted on a hostile shore. Finally, an Overseas Study Tour (OST) in Cambodia, Malaysia, Nepal, the Philippines, Sri Lanka, and Saudi Arabia imparted knowledge of the respective nations' cultures, traditions, and Armed Forces to the course participants.

Fourth Term

The final term is known as the social and cultural term of the course. Apart from the academic activities, it offered a wide range of cultural and social activities to the course participants. It started with argumentative writing EX OVIBAKTI-3. The day-long Liberation War Symposium has regenerated the vigour of patriotism among the course participants through the experience sharing of our valiant war veterans. EX SHOMOR NAKSHA shaped the course participants' understanding of the strategic analysis process. EX GYAN JACHAI-3 was conducted to review the learning of Term-3. Then the course participants presented their IRP and tried to establish their findings before a learned panel. EX BHABISYAT divulged knowledge on force structuring in a joint environment at the operational level. Then, the fundamental understanding of joint planning of war in a joint environment was tested through a three-week-long tactical EX AGNI BEENA. Practical planning of a campaign and major operations was practised during this exercise. Finally, the course ended with a series of social programmes like Golden Evening, International Day, Gala Night and the ultimate Graduation Ceremony with the presence of the Honourable Prime Minister.

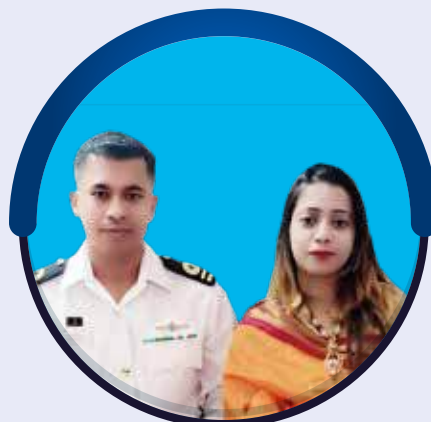

COURSE RESUME

AIR WING (DSCSC COURSE 2022)

Orientation

The DSCSC Course 2022 commenced with the participation of 36 Air Wing officers and their families on 20 February 2022. 24 course participants from Bangladesh Air Force and 12 course participants from the air forces of seven friendly countries joined the course. The chronicle began one week before the commencement of the main course when the course participants and their families started moving into DSCSC residences. After completing the necessary formalities and preparations, the course participants were ready to start the long and exciting course ahead.

First Term

The course started with a grand Flag Raising Ceremony on 20 February 2022. The senior course participants from all participating nations raised their respective national flags in front of the Sheikh Hasina Complex. After that, briefings were conducted on administrative and general service-related issues. The ice-breaking ceremony on the first day of the course prepared the participants for the long and arduous journey ahead. Then, the term resumed its regular schedule. Exercise GYAN JACHAI-1 was conducted, where course participants appreciated their knowledge levels on fundamental air power concepts. The JSSDM open-book examination was a review of our grip on SD-related topics. Exercise MUKTOCHINTA-1 was the first opportunity to improve our writing skills through the writing of an analytical essay. Following that, Exercise SHOTRUR PURVABASH was conducted to impart knowledge on the process of Air Intelligence Planning of the Battlefield (AIPB). During Exercise SHOMOR ANGON, course participants examined and analysed the function of airpower in various conflicts throughout history. In addition, prominent speakers led the central classes, which added to the learning dimensions. Besides all these, orientation with research methodologies for individual research papers (IRP) and topic finalisation enabled us to pursue IRP from the start.

Second Term

After the first term break, the course participants returned with high zeal and enthusiasm. At the very outset, writing a short argumentative essay in the form of Exercise OVIBAKTI-1 strengthened the writing skills of the course participants. For many of them, it was their first exposure to argumentative writing. Exercise MUKTOCHINTA-2 gave course participants the scope to progress their analytical ability. Exercise DHALKHELA-1 was a unique opportunity to learn about Defensive Counter Air Operations (DCAO). The challenges of electronic warfare were mainly focused on in Exercise DHALKHELA-2. Shielded with the knowledge of air defence, the course participants clearly understood Offensive Counter Air Operations (OCAO) from Exercise BAJRAGHAT. Through Exercise DRISHTIKONE, course participants could understand the intricacies of land and maritime warfare to integrate the concept of air operations. Meanwhile, different seminars on national and international affairs enriched the course participants' knowledge. However, course participants remained busy throughout the term learning and preparing presentations on the "Evolution of Military Affairs." By the end of the term, Air Wing course participants became confident enough about the employment of airpower in different roles.

Third Term

Exercises OVIBAKTI-2 and MUKTOCHINTA-3 marked the beginning of the most intense term of the course. Exercise NETRITTER DORSHON allowed the course participants to formulate the command philosophy as a unit's commanding officer. The Air Power Symposium exposed them to contemporary air power roles, innovations, and challenges. By planning and executing a Command Post Exercise (CPX) as part of Exercise AGNI BAAN, course participants gained a comprehensive understanding of air operations and the methodologies for employing airpower. Principal emphasis was given to joint syndicate discussions to teach military strategy and operational art during the term. Exercise GUNGCHILL was conducted at Chattogram with Navy Wing course participants to provide a simulation-based plan validation experience. Fourth Term

The final term commenced with Exercise OVIBAKTI-3, followed by GYAN JACHAI-3. Exercise SHOMOR NAKSHA provided the Air Wing course participants with a comprehensive understanding of the procedure for conducting Strategic Analysis to generate viable policy alternatives and the method for translating Strategic Guidance into Military Strategic Directives. Exercise BHABISHYAT exposed course participants to the procedure entailed in formulating Forces Goal. The last exercise, Exercise AGNI BEENA, consisted of three distinct phases. The three-week-long exercise included developing a support campaign plan at the services headquarters, followed by executing the plan via CPX. All course participants completed the task by demonstrating their decision-making ability through knowledge and learning attained from the course. The year 2020 and 2021 have been quite difficult for all of us due to sudden outbreak of COVID Pandemic. Despite of many limitations and challenges, we continued our daily educational activities virtually and later on physically from the newly constructed school building since September 2021.

In 2022, after 37 years, the school started its journey afresh with great enthusiasm and spirit, renamed as "Torch International School" as a registered English Medium School. Besides, we also implemented Online Payment System through our dedicated domain and newly developed Website. 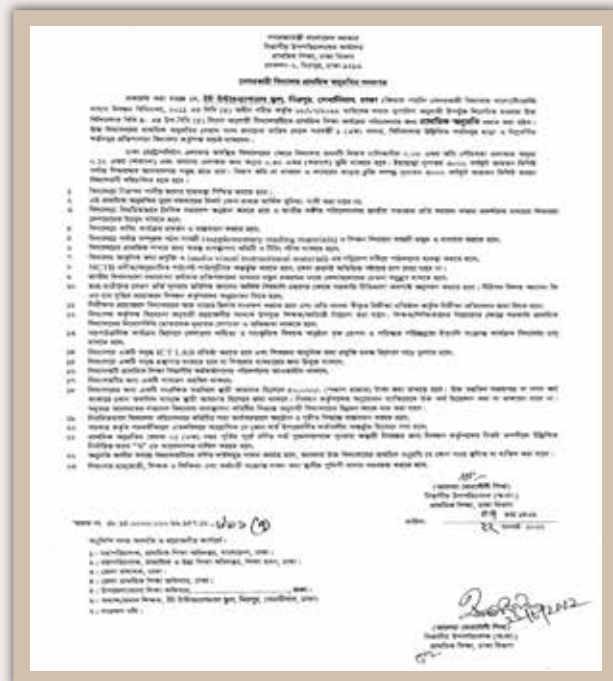

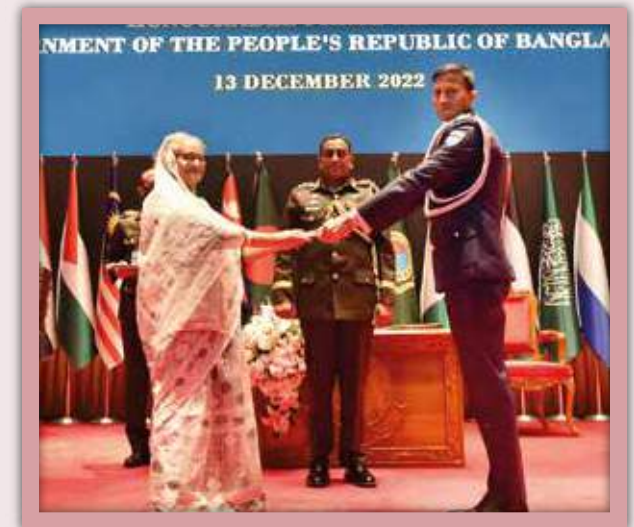
